

The Revelation Of Jesus Christ

1:1 The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave to Him, to show to His servant's things which must shortly come to pass; and He made it known through signs, sending it by His angel to His servant John:

1:2 Who bore record of the word of God, and of the testimony of Jesus Christ, and of all things that he saw.

1:3 Blessed is he that reads, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written in it: for the time is at hand.

1:4 John to the seven assemblies whom are in Asia: Grace to you, and peace, from Him whom is, and who was, and whom is to come; and from the seven Spirits whom are before His throne;

1:5 And from Jesus Christ, whom is the faithful witness, and the first begotten of the dead, and the ruler of the kings of the earth. To Him that loved us, and washed us from our sins in His own blood,

1:6 And has made us a kingdom of priests to God and His Father; to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen.

1:7 Behold, He comes with clouds; and every eye will see Him, and also they who pierced Him: and all the tribes of the land will wail because of Him. Even so, Amen.

1:8 **I am Alpha and Omega, the Beginning and the Ending,** says the Lord, **Who is, and who was, and who is to come, the Almighty.**

1:9 I John, whom also am your brother, and companion in the tribulation, and in the kingdom and patience of Jesus Christ, was on the isle that is called Patmos, for the word of God, and for the testimony of Jesus Christ.

1:10 I was in the Spirit on the Day of the Lord, and heard behind me a great voice, as of a trumpet,

1:11 Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the First and the Last: and, What you see, write in a book, and send it to the seven assemblies whom are in Asia; to Ephesus, and to Smyrna, and to Pergamos, and to Thyatira, and to Sardis, and to Philadelphia, and to Laodicea.

1:12 So I turned to see the voice that spoke with me. And being turned, I saw seven golden candlesticks;

1:13 In the middle of the seven candlesticks one like the Son of man, clothed with a robe down to the foot, and wrapped about the chest with a golden sash.

1:14 His head and His hair was white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes were as a flame of fire;

1:15 And His feet like burnished bronze, as if they burned in a furnace; and His voice as the sound of many waters.

1:16 And He had in his right hand seven stars: and out of His mouth went a sharp two-edged sword: and His countenance was as the sun shining in its strength.

1:17 When I saw Him, I fell at His feet as dead. But He laid His right hand on me, saying to me, Fear not; I am the first and the last:

1:18 I am He that lives, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of Hades and of Death.

1:19 Write the things which you have seen, and the things which are, and the things which are about to be afterwards;

1:20 The mystery of the seven stars which you saw in My right hand, and the seven golden candlesticks. The seven stars are the angels of the seven assemblies: and the seven candlesticks which you saw are the seven assemblies.

2:1 To the angel of the assembly of Ephesus write; These things says He that holds the seven stars in His right hand, who walks in the middle of the seven golden candlesticks;

2:2 I know your works, and your labor, and your patience, and how you cannot bear those whom are evil: and you have tried those

whom say they are apostles, and are not, and have found them liars:

2:3 And have endured, and have patience, and for My name's sake have labored, and have not fainted.

2:4 Nevertheless I have something against you, because you have left your first love.

2:5 Therefore remember from where you have fallen, and repent, and do the first works; or else I will come to you quickly, and will remove your candlestick out of its place, unless you repent.

2:6 But you have this, that you hate the deeds of the laity-conquerors, which I also hate.

2:7 He that has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the assemblies; To him that overcomes will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the middle of the Paradise of God.

2:8 To the angel of the assembly in Smyrna write; These things says the First and the Last, who was dead, and is alive;

2:9 I know your works, and tribulation, and poverty, (but you are rich) and I know the blasphemy of those who say they are Jews, and are not, but are the synagogue of Satan.

2:10 Fear none of those things which you are about to suffer: Behold, the devil is about to cast some of you into prison, that you may be tried; and you will have tribulation ten days: Be faithful to death, and I will give you a crown of life.

2:11 He that has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the assemblies; He whom overcomes will not be hurt by the second death.

2:12 And to the angel of the assembly in Pergamos write; These things says He who has the sharp two-edged sword;

2:13 I know your works, and where you dwell, even where Satan's throne is: and you hold fast My name, and have not denied My faith, even in those days in which Antipas was My faithful martyr, who was slain among you, where Satan dwells.

2:14 But I have a few things against you, because you have there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam, who taught Balak to cast a stumbling block before the children of Israel, to eat things sacrificed to idols, and to commit sexual immorality.

2:15 So have you also them that hold the doctrine of the laity-conquerors, which thing I hate.

2:16 Repent; or else I will come to you quickly, and will fight against them with the sword of My mouth.

2:17 He that has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the assemblies; To him whom overcomes will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no one knows except he that receives it.

2:18 And to the angel of the assembly in Thyatira write; These things says the Son of God, who has His eyes like a flame of fire, and His feet are like burnished bronze;

2:19 I know your works, and love, and service, and faith, and your patience, and your works; and the last to be more than the first.

2:20 Nonetheless, I have a few things against you, because you permitted that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, to teach and to seduce my servants to commit sexual immorality, and to eat things sacrificed to idols.

2:21 I gave her time to repent of her sexual immorality; and she repented not.

2:22 Behold, I will cast her into a bed of anguish, and them that commit adultery with her into great tribulation, unless they repent of their deeds.

2:23 And I will strike her children with death; and all the assemblies will know that I am He who searches minds and hearts; and I will give to everyone of you according to your deeds.

2:24 But to you I say, and to the rest in Thyatira, as many as have not this doctrine, and who have not known the depths of Satan, as they speak; I will place on you no other burden.

2:25 But that which you have already hold fast until I come.

2:26 And he that overcomes, and does my will to the end, to him will I give power over the nations:

2:27 And he will rule them with a rod of iron; as the vessels of a potter will they be broken to pieces: just as I received authority from My Father.

2:28 And I will give him the morning star.

2:29 He that has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the assemblies.

3:1 And to the angel of the assembly in Sardis write; These things says He that has the seven Spirits of God, and the seven stars; I know your works, that you have a name that you live, but are dead.

3:2 Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain, that are about to die: for I have not found your works complete before God.

3:3 Therefore remember how you have received and heard, and hold fast, and repent. Therefore if you will not watch, I will come on you as a thief, and you will not know what hour I will come on you.

3:4 You have a few names even in Sardis who have not defiled their garments; and they will walk with Me in white: for they are worthy.

3:5 He that overcomes, the same will be clothed in white clothing; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before My Father, and before His angels.

3:6 He that has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the assemblies.

3:7 And to the angel of the assembly in Philadelphia write; These things says He that is Holy, He that is true, He that has the key of David, He that opens, and no one shuts; and shuts, and no one opens;

3:8 I know your works: Behold, I have set before you an open door, and no man can shut it: for you have a little strength, and have kept My word, and have not denied My name.

3:9 Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, who say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; Behold, I will make them come and worship before your feet, and to know that I have loved you.

3:10 Because you have kept the word of My patience, I also will keep you from the hour of tribulation, which is about to come on the entire Roman world, to test them that dwell upon the land.

3:11 Behold, I come quickly: hold fast that which you have, that no one may take your crown.

3:12 Him that overcomes I will make a pillar in the temple of My God, and he will go no more out: and I will write on him the name of My God, and the name of the city of My God, which is New Jerusalem, who continually comes down out of heaven from My God: and I will write on him My new name.

3:13 He that has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the assemblies.

3:14 And to the angel of the assembly of the Laodiceans write; These things says the Amen, the faithful and true Witness, the beginning of the creation of God;

3:15 I know your works, that you are neither cold nor hot: I would rather you were either cold or hot.

3:16 So then because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I am about to spit you out of My mouth.

3:17 Because you say, I am rich, and increased with possessions, and have need of nothing; and know not that you are wretched, and miserable, and poor, and blind, and naked:

3:18 I advise you to buy from Me gold tried in the fire, that you may be rich; and white clothing, that you may be clothed, and that the shame of your nakedness does not appear; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you may see.

3:19 As many as I love, I rebuke and discipline: Therefore be zealous and repent.

3:20 Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if anyone hear My voice, and opens the door, I will come in to him, and will eat with him, and he with Me.

3:21 To him that overcomes will I grant to sit with Me on My throne, just as I also overcame, and have sat down with My Father on His throne.

3:22 He that has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the assemblies.

4:1 After this I looked, and, behold, a door was opened in heaven: and the first voice which I heard was as it were of a trumpet talking with me; which said, **Come up to here, and I will show you things which must be afterwards.**

4:2 Immediately I was in the spirit: and, behold, a throne was set in heaven, and One sat on the throne.

4:3 He that sat was to look on like a jasper and a sardine stone: and there was a rainbow around the throne, in sight like an emerald.

4:4 Around the throne were twenty-four thrones: and on the thrones I saw twenty-four elders sitting, clothed in white garments; and they had on their heads crowns of gold.

4:5 And out of the throne preceded lightning and thundering and voices: and there were seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, whom are the seven Spirits of God.

4:6 Before the throne there was a sea of glass like crystal: and in the middle of the throne, and around the throne, were four living creatures full of eyes before and behind.

4:7 The first creature was like a lion, and the second creature like a bull, and the third creature had a face as a man, and the fourth creature was like a flying eagle.

4:8 And the four living creatures each had six wings about him; and they were full of eyes around and within: and they rest not

day and night, saying, Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, who was, and is, and is to come.

4:9 And when those living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, who lives forever and ever,

4:10 The twenty-four elders fall down before Him who sits on the throne, and worship Him who lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying,

4:11 You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power: for You have created all things, and for Your pleasure they are and were created.

5:1 So I saw in the right hand of Him that sat on the throne a book written on the front and on the back, sealed with seven seals.

5:2 Then I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals of it?

5:3 And no man in heaven, nor in earth, neither under the earth, was able to open the book, neither to look in it.

5:4 So I wept much, because no man was found worthy to open and to read the book, neither to look in it.

5:5 Then one of the elders says to me, Weep not: Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals of it.

5:6 And I beheld, and, look, in the middle of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the middle of the elders, stood a Lamb as if it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, whom are the seven Spirits of God sent out into all the earth.

5:7 Then He came and took the book out of the right hand of Him that sat upon the throne.

5:8 And when He had taken the book, the four living creatures and twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, having every one of them harps, and golden bowls full of incense, which represent the prayers of saints.

5:9 So they sung a new song, saying, You are worthy to take the book, and to break the seals of it: for You were slain, and have redeemed us to God by Your blood out of every tribe, and tongue, and people, and nation;

5:10 And have made us to our God a kingdom of priests: and we will reign on the earth.

5:11 So I beheld, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne and the living creatures and the elders: and the number of them was myriads upon myriads, and thousands upon thousands;

5:12 Saying with a loud voice, Worthy is the Lamb who was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honor, and glory, and blessing.

5:13 Then every creature whom is in heaven, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honor, and glory, and power, be to Him that sits upon the throne, and to the Lamb forever and ever.

5:14 The four living creatures said, Amen. And the twenty-four elders fell down and worshipped Him that lives forever and ever.

6:1 Then I saw when the Lamb opened one of the seals, and I heard, as it were the voice of thunder, one of the four creatures saying, Come and see!

6:2 And I saw, and behold a white horse: and He that sat on him had a bow; and a crown was given to Him: and He went out conquering, and to conquer.

6:3 And when He had opened the second seal, I heard the second living creature say, Come and see!

6:4 And there went out another horse that was red: and power was given to him that sat on it to take peace from the land, and that they should kill one another: and there was given to him a great sword.

6:5 And when He had opened the third seal, I heard the third living creature say, Come and see! And I beheld, and look a black horse; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand.

6:6 Then I heard a voice in the middle of the four creatures say, A measure of wheat for a denarius, and three measures of barley for a denarius; and see you hurt not the oil and the wine.

6:7 And when He had opened the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth living creature say, Come and see!

6:8 And I looked, and behold a green horse: and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell followed with him. And power was given to them over the fourth part of the land, to kill with sword, and with hunger, and with plague, and with the wild beasts of the land.

6:9 When he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held:

6:10 So they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, Oh Lord, holy and true, do you not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the land?

6:11 Then white robes were given to everyone of them; and it was said to them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellow servants also and their brothers, that were about to be killed as they were, should be fulfilled.

6:12 And I beheld when He had opened the sixth seal, and, behold, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the whole moon became as blood;

6:13 And the stars of heaven fell to the earth, just as a fig tree casts her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind.

6:14 And the heavens departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places.

6:15 Then the kings of the land, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every slave,

and every free man, hid themselves in the caves and in the rocks of the mountains;

6:16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of Him that sits on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb:

6:17 For the great day of His wrath has come; and who will be able to stand?

7:1 After these things I saw four angels standing on the four corners of the land, holding the four winds of the land, that the wind should not blow on the land, nor on the sea, nor on any tree.

7:2 And I saw another angel ascending from the east, having the seal of the living God: and he cried with a loud voice to the four angels, to whom it was given to hurt the land and the sea,

7:3 Saying, Hurt not the land, neither the sea, nor the trees, until we have sealed the servants of our God on their foreheads.

7:4 For I heard the number of those who were sealed: and there were sealed one hundred and forty-four thousand of all the tribes of the children of Israel.

7:5 Of the tribe of Judah were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Reuben were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Gad were sealed twelve thousand.

7:6 Of the tribe of Aser were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Nephthalim were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Manasses were sealed twelve thousand.

7:7 Of the tribe of Simeon were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Levi were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Issachar were sealed twelve thousand.

7:8 Of the tribe of Zabulon were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Joseph were sealed twelve thousand. Of the tribe of Benjamin were sealed twelve thousand.

7:9 After this I saw, and, behold, a great multitude, who no man could number, of all nations, and tribes, and people, and tongues,

stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, and palms in their hands;

7:10 And cried with a loud voice, saying, Salvation to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb.

7:11 And all the angels stood around the throne, and about the elders and the four living creatures, and fell before the throne on their faces, and worshipped God,

7:12 Saying, Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honor, and power, and might, be to our God forever and ever. Amen.

7:13 And one of the elders answered, saying to me, Who are these who are arrayed in white robes? From where came they?

7:14 So I said to him, Sir, you know. And he said to me, These are they who came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes, and made them white in the blood of the Lamb.

7:15 Therefore they are before the throne of God, and serve Him day and night in His temple: and He that sits on the throne will tabernacle among them.

7:16 They will hunger no more, neither thirst any more; neither will the sun light on them, nor any heat.

7:17 For the Lamb whom is in the middle of the throne will feed them, and will lead them to living fountains of waters: and God will wipe away every tear from their eyes.

8:1 When He had opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven about half an hour.

8:2 And I saw the seven angels who stood before God; and to them were given seven trumpets.

8:3 Another angel came and stood at the altar, having a golden censer; and there was given to him much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all saints on the golden altar which was before the throne.

8:4 For the smoke of the incense, which came with the prayers of the saints, ascended up before God out of the angel's hand.

8:5 And the angel took the censer, and filled it with fire from the altar, and cast it into the land: and there were voices, and thundering, and lightning, and an earthquake.

8:6 Then the seven angels who had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound.

8:7 The first angel sounded, and there followed hail and fire mingled with blood, and they were cast on the land: and the third part of trees was burnt up, and all green grass was burnt up.

8:8 And the second angel sounded, and something like a great mountain burning with fire was cast into the sea: and the third part of the sea became blood;

8:9 And the third part of the creatures which were in the sea, and had life, died; and the third part of the ships were destroyed.

8:10 Then the third angel sounded, and there fell a great star from heaven, burning as it were a torch, and it fell on the third part of the rivers, and on the fountains of waters;

8:11 The name of the star is called Wormwood: and the third part of the waters became wormwood; and many men died of the waters, because they were made bitter.

8:12 And the fourth angel sounded, and the third part of the sun was smitten, and the third part of the moon, and the third part of the stars; so as the third part of them was darkened, and the day shone not for a third part of it, and the night likewise.

8:13 So I beheld, and heard an eagle flying through mid-heaven, saying with a loud voice, Woe, woe, woe, to those that dwell upon the land because of the remaining blasts of the trumpet of the other three angels, which are about to sound!

9:1 And the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven to the earth: and to him was given the key of the bottomless pit.

9:2 So he opened the Abyss; and there arose a smoke out of the well, as the smoke of a burning furnace; and the sun and the air were darkened by reason of the smoke of the well.

9:3 Then there came out of the smoke locusts on the land: and to them was given power, as the scorpions of the land have power.

9:4 For it was commanded them that they should not hurt the grass of the land, neither any green thing, neither any tree; but only those men which have not the seal of God on their foreheads.

9:5 And to them it was given that they should not kill them, but that they should be tormented five months: and their torment was as the torment of a scorpion, when he strikes a man.

9:6 And in those days will men seek death, and will not find it; and will desire to die, and death will flee from them.

9:7 The shapes of the locusts were like horses prepared for battle; and on their heads were as it were crowns like gold, and their faces were as the faces of men.

9:8 They had hair as the hair of women, and their teeth were as the teeth of lions.

9:9 They had breastplates, as it were breastplates of iron; and the sound of their wings was as the sound of chariots, of many horses running to battle.

9:10 They had tails like scorpions, and there were stings in their tails: and their power was to hurt men five months.

9:11 They had a king over them, which is the angel of the Abyss, whose name in the Hebrew tongue is Abaddon, but in the Greek tongue has his name Apollyon.

9:12 One woe is past; and, behold, there come two woes more after that.

9:13 Then the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God,

9:14 Saying to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, Loose the four angels whom are bound in the great river Euphrates.

9:15 So the four angels were loosed, who were prepared for an hour, and a day, and a month, and a year, for to slay the third part of men.

9:16 And the number of the army of the horsemen were myriads upon myriads: and I heard the number of them.

9:17 Thus I saw the horses in the vision, and them that sat on them, having breastplates of fire, and of hyacinth, and brimstone: and the heads of the horses were as the heads of lions; and out of their mouths issued fire and smoke and brimstone.

9:18 By these three was the third part of men killed, by the fire, and by the smoke, and by the brimstone, which issued out of their mouths.

9:19 For their power is in their mouth, and in their tails: for their tails were like serpents, and had heads, and with them they do hurt.

9:20 And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship demons, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:

9:21 Neither repented they of their murders, nor of their sorceries, nor of their sexual immorality, nor of their thefts.

10:1 Then I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow was on his head, and his face was as it were the sun, and his legs as pillars of fire:

10:2 He had in his hand a little book open: and he put his right foot on the sea, and his left foot on the land,

10:3 And cried with a loud voice, as when a lion roars: and when he had cried, seven thunders uttered their voices.

10:4 And when the seven thunders had uttered their voices, I was about to write: and I heard a voice from heaven saying to me, Seal up those things which the seven thunders uttered, and write them not.

10:5 And the angel whom I saw stand on the sea and on the land lifted up his right hand to heaven,

10:6 And swore by Him that lives for ever and ever, who created heaven, and the things that are in it, and the earth, and the things that are in it, and the sea, and the things which are in it, that there should be delay no longer:

10:7 But in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he is about to sound, the mystery of God should be finished, as He has declared to his servants the prophets.

10:8 Then the voice which I heard from heaven spoke to me again, and said, Go and take the little book which is open in the hand of the angel who stands on the sea and upon the land.

10:9 So I went to the angel, and said to him, Give me the little book. And he said to me, Take it, and eat it up; and it will make your stomach bitter, but it will be in your mouth sweet as honey.

10:10 So I took the little book out of the angel's hand, and ate it up; and it was in my mouth sweet as honey: and as soon as I had eaten it, my stomach was bitter.

10:11 Then he said to me, You must prophesy again before many peoples, and nations, and tongues, and kings.

11:1 Then there was given me a reed like unto a rod: and the angel stood, saying, Rise, and measure the temple of God, and the altar, and them that worship in it.

11:2 But the court which is outside the temple leave out, and measure it not; for it is given to the nations: and the holy city will they tread under foot forty-two months.

11:3 And I will give power to My two witnesses, and they will prophesy a thousand two hundred and sixty days, clothed in sackcloth.

11:4 These are the two olive trees, and the two candlesticks standing before the God of the land.

11:5 And if anyone will hurt them, fire proceeds out of their mouth, and devours their enemies: and if anyone will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.

11:6 These have power to shut heaven, that it rain not in the days of their prophecy: and have power over waters to turn them to blood, and to smite the land with all plagues, as often as they will.

11:7 When they have finished their testimony, the beast that ascends out of the Abyss will make war against them, and will overcome them, and kill them.

11:8 And their dead bodies will lie in the street of the great city, which spiritually is called Sodom and Egypt, where also our Lord was crucified.

11:9 For they of the people and tribes and tongues and nations will see their dead bodies three and a half days, and will not permit their dead bodies to be put in graves.

11:10 So they that dwell on the land will rejoice over them, and make merry, and will send gifts one to another; because these two prophets tormented them that dwelt on the land.

11:11 But after three and a half days the spirit of life from God entered into them, and they stood on their feet; and great fear fell on those who saw them.

11:12 And they heard a great voice from heaven saying to them, Come up to here. And they ascended up to heaven in a cloud; and their enemies beheld them.

11:13 The same hour was there a great earthquake, and the tenth part of the city fell, and in the earthquake were slain of men seven thousand: and the remnant were frightened, and gave glory to the God of heaven.

11:14 The second woe is past; and, behold, the third woe comes quickly.

11:15 And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and He will reign forever and ever.

11:16 So the twenty-four elders, who sat before God on their thrones, fell on their faces, and worshipped God,

11:17 Saying, We give You thanks, Oh LORD God Almighty, who is, and was, and is to come; because You have taken to You Your great power, and have reigned.

11:18 The nations were angry, and Your wrath has come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that You should give reward to Your servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear Your name, small and great; and should destroy those who destroy the land.

11:19 So the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the Ark of the Covenant: and there were lightning, and voices, and thundering, and an earthquake, and a hailstorm.

12:1 And there appeared a great sign in heaven; a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and on her head a crown of twelve stars:

12:2 So she being with child cried, travailing in birth, and pained to be delivered.

12:3 Then there appeared another sign in heaven; and behold a great red dragon, having seven heads and ten horns, and seven crowns on his heads.

12:4 And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the land: and the dragon stood before the woman who was about to be delivered, for to devour her Child as soon as it was born.

12:5 For she brought out a Man Child, who was about to rule all nations with a rod of iron: and her Child was caught up to God, and to His throne.

12:6 Then the woman fled into the wilderness, where she had a place prepared of God, that they should feed her there a thousand two hundred and sixty days.

12:7 So there was war in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels,

12:8 And prevailed not; neither was their place found anymore in heaven.

12:9 For the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, who deceives the Roman world: he was cast out into the land, and his angels were cast out with him.

12:10 Then I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now has come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brothers was cast down, who accused them before our God day and night.

12:11 So they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives to the death.

12:12 Therefore rejoice, you heavens, and you that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabitants of the land and of the sea! For the devil has come down to you, having great wrath, because he knows that he has but a short time.

12:13 When the dragon saw that he was cast to the land, he persecuted the woman who brought out the Man Child.

12:14 So to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.

12:15 And the serpent cast out of his mouth water as a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be taken away by the flood.

12:16 But the land helped the woman, and the land opened her mouth, and swallowed up the flood which the dragon cast out of his mouth.

12:17 And the dragon was very angry with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, who keep the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ.

13:1 So I stood on the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and on his horns ten crowns, and on his heads the name of blasphemy.

13:2 For the beast which I saw was like a leopard, and his feet were as the feet of a bear, and his mouth as the mouth of a lion: and the dragon gave him his power, and his throne, and great authority.

13:3 Then I saw one of his heads as it were wounded to death; and his deadly wound was healed: and the whole land wondered after the beast.

13:4 So they worshipped the dragon which gave power to the beast: and they worshipped the beast, saying, Who is like the beast? Who is able to make war with him?

13:5 For there was given to him a mouth speaking great things and blasphemies; and power was given to him to continue forty-two months.

13:6 Then he opened his mouth in blasphemy against God, to blaspheme His name, and His tabernacle, and those that tabernacle in heaven.

13:7 And it was given to him to make war with the saints, and to overcome them: and power was given him over all tribes, and tongues, and nations.

13:8 So all that dwell on the land will worship him, whose names are not written in the book of life of the Lamb slain from the foundation of the world.

13:9 If anyone has an ear, let him hear.

13:10 He that leads into captivity will go into captivity: he that kills with the sword must be killed with the sword. Here is the patience and the faith of the saints.

13:11 And I beheld another beast coming up out of the land; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spoke as a dragon.

13:12 For he exercises all the power of the first beast before him, and causes those who dwell in the land to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed.

13:13 And he does great wonders, so that he makes fire come down from heaven on the land in the sight of men,

13:14 But deceives them that dwell on the land by the means of those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the land, that they should make an image to the beast, who had the wound by a sword, and did live.

13:15 For he had power to give life to the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.

13:16 So he causes all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a mark on their right hand, or on their foreheads:

13:17 So that no man might buy or sell, except he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name.

13:18 Here is wisdom. Let him that has understanding calculate the number of the beast: for it is the number of a man; and his number is 666.

14:1 Then I looked, and behold, a Lamb stood on the mount Zion, and with Him a hundred and forty-four thousand, having His Father's name written on their foreheads.

14:2 And I heard a voice from heaven, as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of a great thunder: and I heard the voice of harpers harping with their harps:

14:3 And they sung as it were a new song before the throne, and before the four living creatures, and the elders: and no one could learn that song but the hundred and forty-four thousand, who were redeemed from the land.

14:4 These are they who were not defiled with women; for they are chaste. These are they which follow the Lamb wherever He goes. These were redeemed from among men, being the first fruits to God and to the Lamb.

14:5 And in their mouth was found no deceit: for they are without fault before the throne of God.

14:6 Then I saw another angel fly in the mid-heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach to them that dwell on the land, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people,

14:7 Saying with a loud voice, Fear God, and give glory to Him; for the hour of His judgment has come: and worship Him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters!

14:8 Then there followed another angel, saying, Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because she made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her adulteries.

14:9 And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark on his forehead, or on his hand,

14:10 The same will drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of His indignation; and he will be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb:

14:11 For the smoke of their torment ascends up forever and ever: and they have no rest either day or night, who worship the beast and his image, and whoever receives the mark of his name.

14:12 Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that obey the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.

14:13 Then I heard a voice from heaven saying to me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from now on: yes, says the Spirit, that they may rest from their labors; and their works do follow them.

14:14 So I looked, and behold a white cloud, and on the cloud one sat like the Son of man, having on his head a golden crown, and in his hand a sharp sickle.

14:15 Yet another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to him that sat on the cloud, Thrust in your sickle, and reap: for the time has come for you to reap; for the harvest of the land is ripe.

14:16 So he that sat on the cloud thrust in his sickle on the land; and the land was reaped.

14:17 Then another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle.

14:18 Yet another angel came out from the altar, who had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in your sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the land; for her grapes are fully ripe.

14:19 So the angel thrust in his sickle into the land, and gathered the vine of the land, and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God.

14:20 For the winepress was trodden outside the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even to the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand and six hundred stadia.

15:1 Then I saw another sign in heaven, great and marvelous, seven angels having the seven last plagues; for in them is filled up the wrath of God.

15:2 For I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and those that had gained the victory over the beast, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name, stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God.

15:3 So they sing the song of Moses the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty; just and true are Your ways, You King of the nations.

15:4 Who will not fear you, O Lord, and glorify Your name? For You only are holy: for all nations will come and worship before You; for Your judgments are made manifest.

15:5 And after that I looked, and, behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened:

15:6 Then the seven angels came out of the temple, having the seven plagues, clothed in pure and white linen, and having their chests wrapped with golden sashes.

15:7 So one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angel's seven golden chalices full of the wrath of God, who lives forever and ever.

15:8 For the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from His power; and no man was able to enter into the temple, until the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled.

16:1 I heard a great voice out of the temple saying to the seven angels, Go your ways, and pour out the chalices of the wrath of God on the land.

16:2 So the first went, and poured out his chalice on the land; and there fell loathsome and malignant sores on the men who had the mark of the beast, and on those who worshipped his image.

16:3 Then the second angel poured out his chalice on the sea; and it became as the blood of a dead man: and every living soul died in the sea.

16:4 And the third angel poured out his chalice on the rivers and fountains of waters; and they became blood.

16:5 Then I heard the angel of the waters say, You are righteous, Oh Lord who is and was and will be, because You have so judged.

16:6 For they have shed the blood of saints and prophets, and You have given them blood to drink; for they are worthy!

16:7 And I heard another out of the altar say, Even so, Lord God Almighty, true and righteous are Your judgments.

16:8 So the fourth angel poured out his chalice on the sun; and power was given to him to scorch men with fire.

16:9 And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God, which has power over these plagues: yet they repented not to give Him glory.

16:10 Then the fifth angel poured out his chalice on the throne of the beast; and his kingdom was full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues for pain,

16:11 And blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and repented not of their deeds.

16:12 So the sixth angel poured out his chalice on the great river Euphrates; and the water of it was dried up, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared.

16:13 For I saw three unclean spirits like frogs come out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet.

16:14 For they are the spirits of demons, working miracles, who go out to the kings of the Roman world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.

16:15 Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed is he that watches, and keeps his garments, unless he walk naked, and they see his shame.

16:16 So he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue Har-Megiddo.

16:17 And the seventh angel poured out his chalice into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, **It is done!**

16:18 So there were voices, and thunders, and lightning; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the land, so mighty an earthquake, and so great.

16:19 Then the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon was remembered before God, to give to her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of His wrath.

16:20 For every island fled away, and the mountains were not found.

16:21 And there fell on men a great hail out of heaven, every stone about the weight of a talent: and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail; for the plague of it was exceedingly great.

17:1 Then there came one of the seven angels who had the seven chalices, and talked with me, saying to me, Come to here; I will show to you the judgment of the great whore that sits on many waters:

17:2 With who the kings of the earth have committed adultery, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her adultery.

17:3 So he carried me away in the spirit into the wilderness: and I saw a woman sit on a scarlet beast, full of names of blasphemy, having seven heads and ten horns.

17:4 For the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her adulteries:

17:5 And on her forehead was a name written, MYSTERY, BABYLON THE GREAT, THE MOTHER OF HARLOTS AND ABOMINATIONS OF THE LAND.

17:6 So I saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus: and when I saw her, I wondered greatly.

17:7 For the angel said to me, Why did you wonder? I will tell you the mystery of the woman, and of the beast that carries her, which has the seven heads and ten horns.

17:8 The beast that you saw was, and is not; and is about to ascend out of the Abyss, and go into perdition: and they that dwell on the land will marvel, whose names were not written in the book of life from the foundation of the world, when they behold the beast that was, and is not, and yet is.

17:9 And here is the mind which has wisdom. The seven heads are seven mountains, on which the woman sits.

17:10 So there are seven Caesars: five are fallen, and one is, and the other is not yet come; and when he comes, he must continue a short time.

17:11 For the beast that was, and is not, even he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and goes into perdition.

17:12 And the ten horns which you saw are ten governors, who have received no kingdom as yet; but receive power as governors one hour with the beast.

17:13 These have one purpose, and will give their power and strength to the beast.

17:14 These will make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them: for He is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with Him are called, and chosen, and faithful.

17:15 And he said to me, The waters which you saw, where the whore sits, are peoples, and multitudes, and nations, and tongues.

17:16 For the ten horns which you saw upon the beast, these will hate the whore, and will make her desolate and naked, and will eat her flesh, and burn her with fire.

17:17 For God has put in their hearts to fulfill His will, and to agree, and give their kingdom to the beast, until the words of God will be fulfilled.

17:18 And the woman which you saw is that great city, which reigns over the kings of the earth.

18:1 After these things I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great power; and the earth was lightened with his glory.

18:2 And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, Babylon the great has fallen, has fallen, and has become the habitation of demons, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.

18:3 For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her adultery, and the kings of the earth have committed adultery

with her, and the merchants of the earth have grown rich through the abundance of her luxury.

18:4 Then I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, My people, that you be not partakers of her sins, and that you receive not of her plagues.

18:5 For her sins have reached to heaven, and God has remembered her iniquities.

18:6 Reward her just as she rewarded you, and double to her double according to her works: in the cup which she has filled fill to her double.

18:7 How much she has glorified herself, and lived luxuriously, so much torment and sorrow give her: for she says in her heart, I sit a queen, and am no widow, and will see no sorrow.

18:8 Therefore will her plagues come in one day, pestilence, and mourning, and famine; and she will be utterly burned with fire: for strong is the Lord God who judges her.

18:9 For the kings of the earth, who have committed adultery and lived luxuriously with her, will bewail her, and lament for her, when they will see the smoke of her burning,

18:10 Standing far off for the fear of her torment, saying, Alas, alas that great city Babylon, that mighty city! For in one hour has your judgment come.

18:11 So the merchants of the earth will weep and mourn over her; for no man buys their merchandise anymore:

18:12 The merchandise of gold, and silver, and precious stones, and of pearls, and fine linen, and purple, and silk, and scarlet, and all citron wood, and all manner of ivory, and all manner of precious wood, and of bronze, and iron, and marble,

18:13 And cinnamon, and incense, and myrrh, and frankincense, and wine, and olive oil, and fine flour, and wheat, and cattle, and sheep, and horses, and chariots, and slaves, and souls of men.

18:14 For the fruits that your soul lusted after have departed from you, and all things which were splendid and rich have departed from you, and you will find them no more at all.

18:15 The merchants of these things, who were made rich by her, will stand far off for the fear of her torment, weeping and wailing,

18:16 And saying, Alas, alas that great city, that was clothed in fine linen, and purple, and scarlet, and decked with gold, and precious stones, and pearls!

18:17 For in one hour so great riches has come to nothing. And every shipmaster, and all the voyagers in ships, and sailors, and as many as trade by sea, stood far off,

18:18 And cried when they saw the smoke of her burning, saying, What city is like this great city?

18:19 So they cast dust on their heads, and cried, weeping and wailing, saying, Alas, alas that great city, in which were made rich all that had ships in the sea by reason of her wealth! For in one hour she was made desolate.

18:20 Rejoice over her, you heaven, and you holy apostles and prophets; for God has judged your judgment on her.

18:21 A mighty angel took up a stone like a great millstone, and cast it into the sea, saying, Thus with violence will that great city Babylon be thrown down, and will be found no more at all.

18:22 So the voice of harpers and musicians, and of flute players, and trumpeters, will be heard no more at all in you; and no craftsman, of whatever craft he be, will be found anymore in you and the sound of a millstone will be heard no more at all in you;

18:23 Then the light of a candle will shine no more at all in you; and the voice of the bridegroom and of the bride will be heard no more at all in you: for your merchants were the great men of the land; for by your sorceries were all nations deceived.

18:24 For in her was found the blood of prophets, and of saints, and of all that were slain upon the land.

19:1 And after these things I heard a great voice of many people in heaven, saying, Alleluia; Salvation, and glory, and honor, and power, to the Lord our God:

19:2 For true and righteous are His judgments: for He has judged the great whore, who did corrupt the earth with her adulteries, and has avenged the blood of His servants.

19:3 Yet again they said, Alleluia And her smoke rose up forever and ever.

19:4 Then the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshipped God who sat on the throne, saying, Amen; Alleluia.

19:5 And a voice came out of the throne, saying, Praise our God, all you his servants, and you that fear Him, both small and great.

19:6 And I heard as it were the voice of a great multitude, and as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of mighty thundering, saying, Alleluia: for the Lord God Almighty reigns.

19:7 Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honor to Him: for the marriage of the Lamb has come, His wife has made herself ready.

19:8 So to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteous deeds of the saints.

19:9 Then he said to me, Write, Blessed are they which are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb. So he said to me, These are the true sayings of God.

19:10 So I fell at his feet to worship him. Then he said to me, See you do it not: I am your fellow servant, and of your brothers that have the testimony of Jesus: worship God: for the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.

19:11 And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and He that sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He does judge and make war.

19:12 His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns; and He had a name written, that no one knew, but He Himself.

19:13 For He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood: and His name is called The Word of God.

19:14 Then the armies who were in heaven followed Him on white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

19:15 And out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should smite the nations: and He will shepherd them with a rod of iron: and He treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God.

19:16 And He has on his robe and on His thigh a name written, KING OF KINGS, AND LORD OF LORDS.

19:17 Then I saw an angel standing in the sun; and he cried with a loud voice, saying to all the birds that fly in mid-heaven, Come and gather yourselves together to the supper of the great God;

19:18 That you may eat the flesh of kings, and the flesh of captains, and the flesh of mighty men, and the flesh of horses, and of those that sit on them, and the flesh of all men, both free and slave, both small and great.

19:19 So I saw the beast, and the kings of the earth, and their armies, gathered together to make war against Him who sat on the horse, and against His army.

19:20 For the beast was taken, and with him the false prophet that worked miracles before him, with which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast, and those who worshipped his image. These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.

19:21 And the remnant were slain with the sword of Him that sat on the horse, which sword proceeded out of His mouth: and all the birds were filled with their flesh.

20:1 Then I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the Abyss and a great chain in his hand.

20:2 So he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, whom is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years,

20:3 And cast him into the Abyss, and shut him up, and set a seal on him, that he should deceive the nations no more, until the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.

20:4 So I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was given to them: and I saw the souls of them that were beheaded for the witness of Jesus, and for the word of God, and who had not worshipped the beast, neither his image, neither had received his mark on their foreheads, or on their hands; and they lived and reigned with Christ a thousand years.

20:5 But the rest of the dead lived not again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection.

20:6 Blessed and holy is he that has part in the first resurrection: on such the second death has no power, but they will be priests of God and of Christ, and will reign with Him a thousand years.

20:7 When the thousand years have expired, Satan will be loosed out of his prison,

20:8 And will go out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Gog, and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea.

20:9 For they went up on the breadth of the land, and encompassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them.

20:10 Then the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

20:11 So I saw a great white throne, and Him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.

20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their deeds.

20:13 For the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them: and they were judged each one according to his deeds.

20:14 Then Death and Hades were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

20:15 So whoever was not found written in the Book of Life was cast into the lake of fire.

21:1 And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away; and there was no more sea.

21:2 Then I John saw the holy city, New Jerusalem, continually coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

21:3 Then I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they will be His people, and God Himself will be with them, and be their God.

21:4 So God will wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there will be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither will there be pain anymore: for the former things have passed away.

21:5 He that sat on the throne said, **Behold, I make all things new!** He said to me, **Write: for these words are faithful and true.**

21:6 And He said to me, **It is paid in full! I am Alpha and Omega, the Beginning and the End. I will give to him who thirsts from the fountain of the water of life freely.**

21:7 **He that overcomes will inherit all things; and I will be His God, and he will be My son.**

21:8 **But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and sexually immoral, and sorcerers, and idolaters,**

and all liars, will have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone: which is the second death.

21:9 So there came to me one of the seven angels who had the seven chalices full of the seven last plagues, and talked with me, saying, Come to here, I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife.

21:10 And he carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me that great city, the holy Jerusalem, continually descending out of heaven from God,

21:11 Having the glory of God: and her light was like to a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal;

21:12 And had a wall great and high, and had twelve gates, and at the gates twelve angels, and names written there on, which are the names of the twelve tribes of the children of Israel:

21:13 On the east three gates; on the north three gates; on the south three gates; and on the west three gates.

21:14 For the wall of the city had twelve foundations, and in them the names of the twelve apostles of the Lamb.

21:15 And he that talked with me had a golden reed to measure the city, and the gates of it, and the wall of it.

21:16 The city lays four square, and the length is as large as the width: and he measured the city with the reed, twelve thousand stadia. The length and the width and the height of it are equal.

21:17 Then he measured the wall of it, a hundred and forty-four cubits, according to the measure of a man, that is, of the angel.

21:18 So the building of the wall of it was of jasper: and the city was pure gold, like clear glass.

21:19 And the foundations of the wall of the city were garnished with all manner of precious stones. The first foundation was jasper; the second, sapphire; the third, a chalcedony; the fourth, an emerald;

21:20 The fifth, sardonyx; the sixth, sardius; the seventh, chrysolite; the eighth, beryl; the ninth, a topaz; the tenth, a chrysoprasus; the eleventh, a jacinth; the twelfth, an amethyst.

21:21 And the twelve gates were twelve pearls: every several gate was of one pearl: and the street of the city was pure gold, as it were transparent glass.

21:22 But I saw no temple in it: for the Lord God Almighty and the Lamb are the temple of it.

21:23 For the city had no need of the sun, neither of the moon, to shine in it: for the glory of God did lighten it, and the Lamb is the light of it.

21:24 And the nations of those who are saved will walk in the light of it: and the kings of the earth will bring their glory and honor into it.

21:25 And the gates of it will not be shut at all by day: for there will be no night there.

21:26 For they will bring the glory and honor of the nations into it

21:27 For there will in no way enter into it anything that defiles, neither whoever works abomination, nor makes a lie: but they who are written in the Lamb's Book of Life.

22:1 Then he showed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb.

22:2 In the midst of it, and on each side of the river, was there the tree of life, which bore twelve manner of fruits, and yielded her fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.

22:3 So there will be no more curse: but the throne of God and of the Lamb will be in it; and His servants will serve Him:

22:4 For they will see His face; and His name will be on their foreheads.

22:5 And there will be no night there; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun; for the Lord God gives them light: and they will reign forever and ever.

22:6 Then he said to me, These sayings are faithful and true: and the Lord God of the holy prophets sent His angel to show to His servants the things which must shortly be done.

22:7 Behold, I come quickly: blessed is he that keeps the sayings of the prophecy of this book.

22:8 So I John saw these things, and heard them. And when I had heard and seen, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel which showed me these things.

22:9 Then said he to me, See you do it not: for I am your fellow servant, and of your brothers the prophets, and of those who keep the sayings of this book: worship God!

22:10 Then he said to me, Seal not the sayings of the prophecy of this book: for the time is at hand!

22:11 He that is unjust, let him be unjust still: and he whom is filthy, let him be filthy still: and he that is righteous, let him be righteous still: and he that is holy, let him be holy still.

22:12 And, behold, I come quickly; and My reward is with Me, to recompense everyone according to what He has done.

22:13 I am Alpha and Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last.

22:14 Blessed are they that do His commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city.

22:15 For outside are dogs, and sorcerers, and the sexually immoral, and murderers, and idolaters, and whoever loves and makes a lie.

22:16 I Jesus have sent My angel to testify to you these things in the assemblies. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, and the Bright Morning Star.

22:17 And the Spirit and the bride say, Come. And let him who hears say, Come. And let him that is thirsty come. And whoever will, let him drink the water of life freely.

22:18 For I testify to everyone that hears the words of the prophecy of this book, If anyone will add to these things, God will add to him the plagues that are written in this book:

22:19 And if anyone will take away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God will take away his part out of the Book of Life, and out of the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book.

22:20 He who testifies these things says, Surely, I come quickly. Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus.

22:21 The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen.
